

DYNAMIC DIAMANTE

Level 4

A Diamante is a seven-line poem that has a diamond shape when it is written down. It does not rhyme and is fun and quite easy to write. Read the Diamante below and then study the explanation of how to write a Diamante.

- Line 1 One word: a topic, a noun
- Line 2 Two describing words
- Line 3 Three action words: verbs ending in 'ing'
- Line 4 A four-word phrase describing feelings about the topic
- Line 5 Three action words: verbs ending in 'ing'
- Line 6 Two describing words
- Line 7 One ending word that is a synonym for the first word



Create a Diamante yourself. Firstly, choose a topic or event to do with Rugby and write down your ideas below,

1. Choose a topic (one word)
2. List some describing words for your topic.
3. Write some action words (verbs) ending in "ing".
4. Write some 4-word phrases that express feelings about your topic.
5. Choose some final words to end your poem. (A synonym for the first word)

Now select the best words from your list of words above to write your own Diamante.
