Colin Meads

Colin Meads was named player of the Century at the NZRU Awards dinner in 1999.

He was sent off in the 1967 test against Scotland.

Meads represented King Country at primary school.

Colin Meads appeared in 133 matches for the All Blacks.

He broke his arm in South Africa in 1970.
