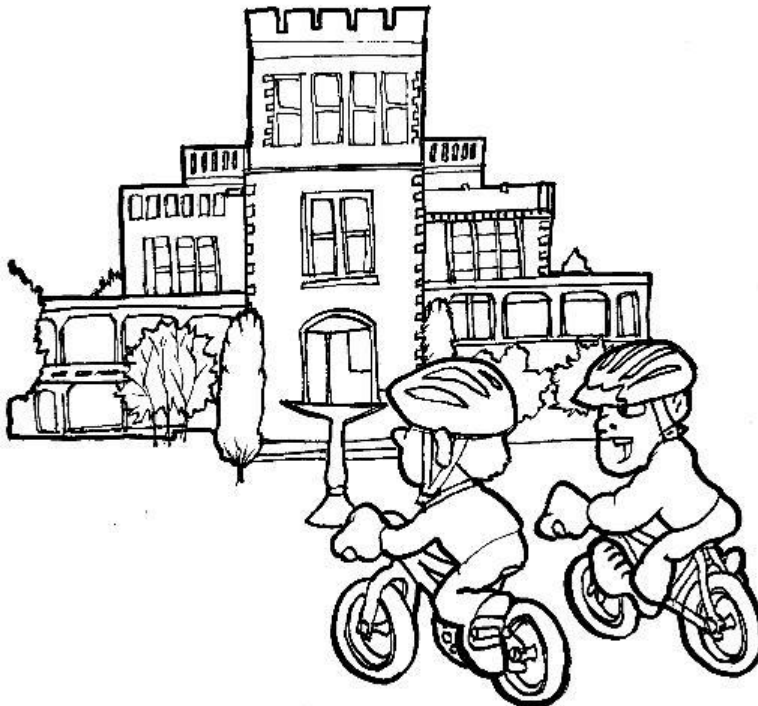
Use reference material to do a mini study on Dunedin and see what links you can make between the city and its founders from Scotland. (A good place to find information about a place is your local information centre and the internet.)
